## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to expand the definition of school zone, to prohibit the transfer and possession of ghost guns, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Angellyh Yambo Gun  
5 Free Zone Expansion Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. GUN FREE SCHOOL ZONES.**

7 Section 921(a) of title 18, United States Code, is  
8 amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (26)(B), by striking “1,000  
2 feet” and inserting “5,000 feet”; and

3           (2) in paragraph (27), by inserting “or an early  
4 childhood education program (as such term is de-  
5 fined in section 103 of the Higher Education Act of  
6 1965)” before the period.

7 **SEC. 3. PROHIBITING GHOST GUNS.**

8           (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922 of title 18, United  
9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
10 lowing:

11           “(aa) GHOST GUN PROHIBITION.—It shall be unlaw-  
12 ful for any person to transfer or possess a ghost gun.”.

13           (b) DEFINITION.—Section 921(a) of title 18, United  
14 States Code, as amended by section 2, is further amended  
15 by inserting after paragraph (37) the following:

16           “(38) The term ‘ghost gun’ means a firearm that  
17 lacks a unique serial number engraved or cast on the  
18 frame or receiver of the firearm by a licensed manufac-  
19 turer or licensed importer in accordance with section  
20 923(i) of title 18, United States Code, and includes any  
21 combination of parts designed or intended to be assem-  
22 bled, or to be used in converting a device, into a firearm.”.
